



Southeast Christian College Athletic Program – Transfer, Disclosure & Scholarship Policy

1. Transfer Notification Requirement

Any student-athlete who intends to transfer to another college or university, for any reason, must provide a minimum of 60 days' written notice prior to their intended transfer date.

If the student-athlete is currently in season, they are expected to complete the athletic season before transferring, unless otherwise approved by the College.

2. Required Communication

Student-athletes must formally notify the following parties:

- Their assigned Coach
- Southeast Christian College Administration

3. External Athletic Participation (Full Disclosure Requirement)

Student-athletes are required to provide full disclosure if they are participating in any external athletic teams, leagues, or training programs outside of Southeast Christian College.

This information must be communicated to both their Coach and the College.

Student-athletes are strictly prohibited from participating in any external athletic activities during the official athletic season unless they receive prior written approval from the Athletic Program Director (Coach Director).

4. Scholarship Confidentiality (Non-Disclosure Policy)

All student-athletes are required to maintain strict confidentiality regarding the type, amount, or terms of any scholarship or financial assistance awarded to them.

Scholarship awards may vary (full or partial) based on availability, institutional criteria, and evaluation by the College administration, Board of Directors, and Athletic Program leadership.

To maintain unity, integrity, and a positive team environment, student-athletes must not disclose or discuss their scholarship details with other students or team members.

5. Compliance & Consequences

Failure to comply with this policy, including failure to provide proper notice, disclose external participation, or maintain scholarship confidentiality, may result in consequences, including but not limited to:

- Loss or adjustment of scholarship
- Suspension from the athletic program
- Additional disciplinary actions as determined by the College
