



## Student Athlete Contract

**The Southeast Christian College athletic code of conduct** is a commitment by all student athletes to exercise good judgement in all affairs, to represent Christ, family, community, and self in the most positive manner at all times, and to encourage others to share these commitments. Student athletes must always consider their actions carefully.

Student athletes participating in intercollegiate competitions are considered leaders and should be constant positive role models. Involvement in the athletic program at **Southeast Christian College** is an honor and a privilege and comes with inherent responsibilities. Involvement in the athletic program is dependent upon compliance with all applicable rules and maintaining all academic requirements.

**As a member of the Southeast Christian College Athletic Program**, your behavior on campus, in the community, and at other institutions, reflects not only on yourself, but on your coach, teammates, family, and Southeast Christian College. Furthermore, as a member of the **Southeast Christian College Athletic Program**, your behavior should reflect the highest Christian principles.

**I understand that, to participate in Southeast Christian College athletics, I must act in accordance with the following:**

- Athletes must abide by all school policies, rules, and procedures.
- Athletes must attend online classes regularly and not miss or fail to submit assignments.
- Athletes must meet the minimum full time student requirement of 12 credits per academic year.
- Athletes must maintain a 2.5 GPA and keep up with all academic requirements and assignments.
- Athletes must respect the teammates, coaches, following directions quickly and not arguing or talking back.
- Athletes must encourage and support their teammates with the highest degree of sportsmanship and cooperation.
- Athletes must conduct themselves with the highest degree of sportsmanship at all games and sporting events. Players may under no circumstances disrespect or argue with the referee. Players must always show respect for the opposing team’s players, coaches, and fans.
- Athletes will show respect to other schools’ property, equipment, and sports facilities.
- While being transported to and from hotels, and games, athletes will always conduct themselves in a Christlike manner. They will abide by the travel schedule, and any adjustments made by the coaching staff while on the road.
